Finance/Employee Benefits & Compensation

• Finances for the eight months (67%) of fiscal year ending April 30, 2018 reflect income has reached 53% of projections; and expenses 50%.

Law Enforcement/Ethics Committee -- No report

Examining Committee

Co-Chair W. Balascio reported the Examining Committee met on January 8, 2018 and reviewed **one hundred nine (109)** applications for licensure including **52** for **comity; 1** application for **initial** licensure; **1** applicant who now meets all licensing requirements after successful passage of the FE exam; **42** applications for individuals who now meet all licensing requirements after successful passage of the October, 2017 PE exam; and **18** applications for **examination**. The committee also reviewed **3** applications for **Certificates of Authorization**; and **7** applications for Certificate of Authorization **Reinstatements**.

Motion by W. Balascio, seconded by Clendaniel, Council approve the Committee's recommendations for applications for licensure and Certificates of Authorization as noted on Exhibits A1-A5 of the committee's report. Approved unanimously.

Subsequent to the meeting, an additional Certificate of Authorization was received needing immediate attention for Anderson Civil Engineering, LLC, which has been determined to meet all requirements.

Motion by W. Balascio, seconded by Retzlaff, Council approve the Certificate of Authorization for Anderson Civil Engineering, LLC. Approved unanimously.
