MINUTES - COUNCIL MEETING, NOVEMBER 9, 2011

A meeting of the Council of the Delaware Association of Professional Engineers was held on Wednesday, November 9, 2011, at the Brick Hotel, Georgetown, Delaware.

Open Forum

Minutes of the October 12, 2011 Council Meeting

Council reviewed the Minutes of the October 12, 2011 Council meeting. Minutes should reflect two amendments:

- Motion by Robertson, Council take no action on Complaint 11/146, and upon correction this complaint be returned to Council at its November meeting for consideration. (Motion was originally withdrawn, and then moved again and passed with a second.)
- Minutes should reflect Secretary Barbato took the Roll call and declared a quorum was present.

Motion by Shine, seconded by Robertson, Council approve the Minutes of the October 12, 2011 Council meeting as amended. Approved unanimously.

D.A.G. Report

 <u>Computer-based testing law revisions</u> – DAG Hickey drafted legislation to address computer-based testing for Council's review, requesting Council also consider a retake policy for FE candidates.
 Research will be done to see how other states are handling this and the recommendations from NCEES.

Executive Session

Motion by Robertson, seconded by Newton, at 3:18 p.m. to enter Executive Session to discuss pending/potential litigation. Approved unanimously.

Motion by Medlarz, seconded by Robertson, Council return to Open Session at 4:00 p.m. Approved unanimously.

Motion by Medlarz, seconded by Robertson, Council authorize DAG Hickey to issue a response to the proposed settlement agreement and prepare for President McAllister's signature. Approved unanimously.

Committee Reports

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee met just prior to the Council meeting, therefore, a written report is unavailable. Items discussed at Executive Committee meeting will be covered under the appropriate Committee reports.

Financial Report

<u>Income/expense activity</u> -- The first six months of the fiscal year reflects income at 55% and expenses at 47% of projections.

Motion by Newton, seconded by Robertson, to approve the Finance Report subject to audit. Approved unanimously.

IT firm (DDS) has prepared a quote for updating and revising our website. This proposal to revamp the current website processes is \$10,000. These monies are unbudgeted and timing would dictate it would not be prudent to wait until the next fiscal year in May, 2012, since we will be in the midst of PE and CA renewals at that time.

Motion by Newton, seconded by Robertson, Council approve the \$10,000 for upgrading the website. Approved unanimously.

<u>Finance Committee Meeting</u> -- Chair Medlarz reported to Council on the Finance Committee meeting held on October 24, 2011. The committee reviewed and discussed the draft audit, fiscal year-end change, records retention, W-9 forms, cash flow program, investments and potential exam fee increases. Auditor has suggested utilizing the services of a bookkeeper to improve the final audit.

Motion by Medlarz, seconded by Newton, Council approve procuring a bookkeeping service. Approved unanimously.

Employee Benefits & Compensation --

Committee discussed reviewing the employee benefits package, as well as health insurance.

Law Enforcement/Ethics Committee

Co-Chair Crouch presented the report of the committee's meeting on November 2, 2011.

- <u>LEE Recommendation Form</u> -- Committee approved use of a recommendation form when forwarding its recommendations to Council for a Consent Agreement, Hearing, etc.
- <u>Case closures</u> -- 7 cases recommended for closure. Motion by Crouch, seconded by Robertson, Council
 approve the closure of the 7 cases listed on Exhibit A of the report dated November 3, 2011. Approved
 unanimously.

Examining Committee

Council reviewed the report of the Examining Committee's meeting of October 26, 2011. Forty (40) individual applications for licensure were reviewed and confidential recommendations made for Council action consisting of **32** applications for **comity**; and **8** applications for **examination**. The Committee also reviewed **5** applications for **Certificates of Authorization**; and **7** requests for Reinstatement.

Motion by Shine, seconded by Robertson, Council approve the recommendations of the Examining Committee as shown on Exhibits A1-A2 of the report dated October 27, 2011, as well as the reinstatement of license #13620, which was inadvertently omitted from the Exhibit. Approved unanimously.
