Minutes of the May 11, 2022 Council Meeting

Council reviewed the Minutes of the May 11, 2022 Council meeting.

Motion by K. Maxson, seconded by C. McAllister, to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2022 meeting as amended to correct a typo. Approved unanimously.

D.A.G. Report

DAG Kelly summarized House Bill 404, which may enable some professional licensing boards to have more discretion to license individuals with criminal convictions. DAPE was not included in this bill, which is now out of Committee.

Financial Reports

M. Clendaniel summarized DAPE's finances for the month (8.3%) of fiscal year ending April 30, 2023, which reflect income has reached 13.6% of projections and expenses 6.8%.

Nominating Committee

Old Business

Council members reviewed and discussed the LEE Memo dated April 6, 2022 related to proposed legislation for successor professional engineer responsibilities. Council also discussed potential formats in order to gather feedback from stakeholders.

Next steps: DAG Kelly will reach out to DAG Mulveny in order to write a summary of the proposal; Council members should send ideas to J. Wootten about individuals/organizations that should be asked to provide feedback.

Council members reviewed and discussed the LEE Memo dated October 11, 2021 related to the proposed definitions of negligence, incompetence and misconduct in the practice of engineering, and offered suggestions for minor edits to the proposed definitions, and potentially adding a definition for "gross negligence" as well. DAG Kelly recommended that the proposed amendments should be made to the Delaware Professional Engineers' Act vs. the Code of Ethics.

Next steps: DAG Kelly will discuss further with DAG Mulveny. Council would like the LEE Committee to propose specific language for a legislative amendment.

LEE Proposed revision to Canon 6.C of the Code of Ethics, borrowing language from the Board of Medicine and other Title 24 boards.

Next steps: DAG Kelly will discuss further with DAG Mulveny. Council would like the LEE Committee to finalize proposed amendment for action at the August Council meeting (LEE Committee does not meet in July).
