Open Forum

Open Council Seat (Chemical Engineering) Appointment

Motion by C. McAllister, seconded by K. Maxson, to approve M. Lennon to fill the open Chemical Engineering seat through August 31, 2023. Approved unanimously.

Minutes of the February 8, 2023 Council Meetings

DAG Kelly will research the State's record and document retention policies.

Financial Reports

K. Maxson summarized DAPE's finances for the ten months (83.3%) of fiscal year ending April 30, 2023, which reflect income has reached 95.0% of projections and expenses 75.8%.

Motion by K. Maxson, seconded by C. McAllister, Council accepts the Finance Report subject to audit. Approved unanimously.

Committee Reports

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee met just prior to the Council meeting, therefore, a written report is unavailable. Items discussed at Executive Committee meeting will be covered under the appropriate Committee reports.

<u>Finance/Employee Compensation & Benefits Committee/Facilities Committee</u>

K. Maxson reported that the committee met on March 1, 2023 and discussed the following:

Law Enforcement/Ethics Committee

J. Wootten will consolidate the legislative amendment feedback and ask DAG Mulvey to take a first pass at additional edits (if needed) so that the LEE Committee can make a recommendation on the final amendment language at their April 5 meeting. J. Wootten will also invite DAG Kelly to attend the April 5 LEE Committee meeting.

Examining Committee

K. Tadler reported that the Committee met on February 22, 2023 and discussed the following:

- Recent news articles regarding a recent scandal involving nursing degrees, and changes to the Delaware Bar exam.

Motion by K. Tadler, seconded by V. Fazio, Council remove the reapplication requirement in Section 2817(7)(g). Approved unanimously.
