# Open Forum

### Minutes of the December 11, 2024 Council Meetings

Council reviewed the Minutes of the December 11, 2024 Council meeting.

Motion by T. Thomson seconded by M. Clendaniel, to approve the minutes of the December 11, 2024 Council meeting as amended to reflect the correct times related to the executive session. Approved unanimously.

#### D.A.G. Report

DAG Naylor provided draft legislative changes to J. Wootten. She'll distribute them to the Government Affairs/Bylaws Committee and schedule a meeting to review. He expects to finalize the hearing committee report for File 24-090 soon. The committee will need to review and approve, and the goal is to present a recommendation to Council on February 12, 2025.

# **Financial Reports**

T. Thomson reported that the finances for the 8 months (66.7%) of fiscal year ending April 30, 2025 reflect income has reached 92.7% of projections and expenses 60.9%.

Motion by T. Thomson, seconded by M. Clendaniel, Council accepts the Finance Report subject to audit. Approved unanimously.

# **Committee Reports**

## **Executive Committee**

The Executive Committee met just prior to the Council meeting, therefore, a written report is unavailable. Items discussed at Executive Committee meeting will be covered under the appropriate Committee reports.

### Law Enforcement/Ethics Committee

T. Thomson reported that the committee met on January 7, 2025 and discussed the following: A licensee attended the meeting to express concern DNREC's requirements related to signing/sealing/dating Certified Construction Review (CCR) reports. This is similar to ongoing questions the Committee has discussed related to what constitutes "final drawings, specifications and documents involving the practice of engineering." After further discussion, Council agrees with the DNREC requirements. The CCR training is available to licensed PEs if they do not feel familiar enough with the CCR requirements and reports. J. Wootten will work with the LEE Committee to prepare an article related to this topic for the next newsletter.

Motion by T. Thomson, seconded by M. Clendaniel, Council approves the closure of 2 cases listed on Exhibit A of committee report. Approved unanimously.

# **Examining Committee**

M. Smith reported that the Committee met on December 18, 2024 and discussed the following:
