#### Minutes of the October 8, 2025 Council Meetings

Council reviewed the Minutes of the October 8, 2025 Council meeting.

Motion by K. Tadler, seconded by D. Reinhold, to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2025 Council meeting. Approved unanimously.

#### Financial Reports

Finances for the 6 months (50%) of fiscal year ending April 30, 2026 reflect income has reached 91.5% of projections and expenses 42.3%. Upon further review, the negative net ordinary income reflected on the income and expense report is correct, and results from higher projected expenses vs. income.

# **Executive Committee**

# **Law Enforcement Committee**

T. Thomson reported that the Committee met on November 5, 2025 and discussed the following:

Revisions to the Code of Ethics. The Committee will discuss further and make a recommendation to Council to amend this document. They are considering adding to the list of crimes substantially related to engineering, using the Board of Architect's regulations as a guideline.

Motion by T. Thomson, seconded by D. Reinhold, Council approves the closure of 9 cases listed on Exhibit A of committee report. Approved unanimously.

Motion by T. Thomson, seconded by D. Reinhold, Council approves the proposed consent order related to File 25-063. Approved unanimously.

# **Examining Committee**

K. Tadler reported that the Committee met on October 29, 2025 and discussed the following:

Proposed revisions to application review guidelines: The committee hopes to finalize this at the next meeting, and will share a redlined copy of the final document with Council.

The committee discussed potential amendments to the Delaware Professional Engineers Act to allow:

- Early test taking for candidates planning to apply through the 15-year experience path. Upon further discussion, the Committee recommends that there not be limitations to any candidates that can take the FE exam (remove 2817(7)e). For candidates applying through the 15-year experience path, they would be permitted to take the PE exam any time after passing the FE exam. Council agreed with this approach.
- Minor edit to Section 2803 (successor engineer)

All recommendations for licensure or approval to take the P&PE exam are shown on Exhibits A1 and A2 which are now ready for Council action. The recommendations are summarized below:
