2019 DAPE COUNCIL ELECTION CLOSES JULY 15

The Delaware Professional Engineers' Act and DAPE's bylaws govern our annual Council elections. Electronic ballots are distributed to eligible voting members (active members who are residents of Delaware and/or employed in Delaware) on June 15, and the election closes July 15. If you have not received a ballot, please contact office@dape.org.

The three open seats are: Private Consulting, Kent County, and Electrical Engineering.

CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORIZATION RENEWAL CHANGES & REMINDERS

Our members approved a few changes to the DAPE bylaws in 2018, including the Certificate of Authorization renewal deadline. As a result, **September 30 will be the new date for the annual renewal of Certificates of Authorization**, beginning in 2019. The renewal window will open on August 1, 2019.

Any firm that is practicing or offering to practice engineering in the State of Delaware needs a Certificate of Authorization. Not sure if your firm is authorized?
